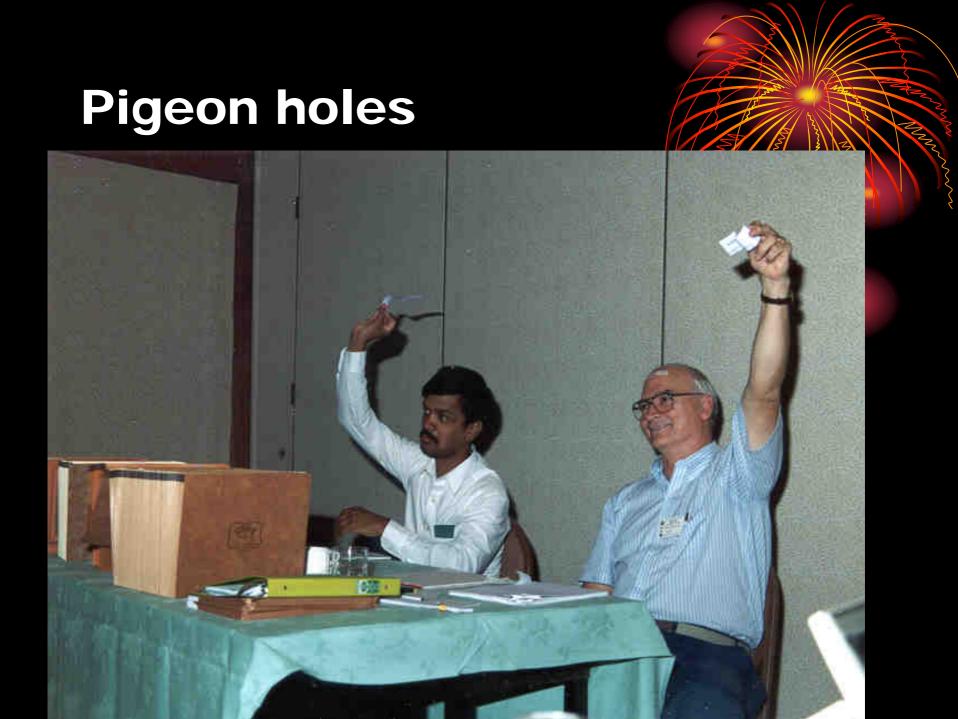

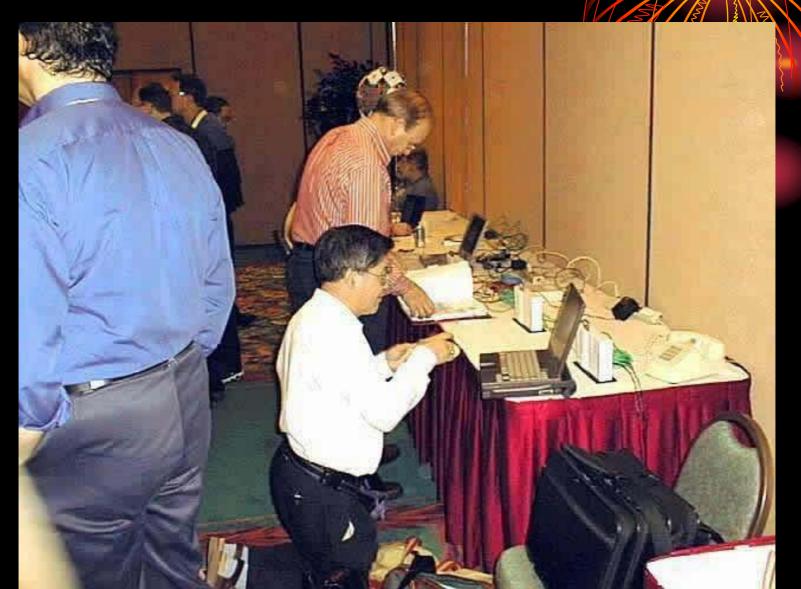

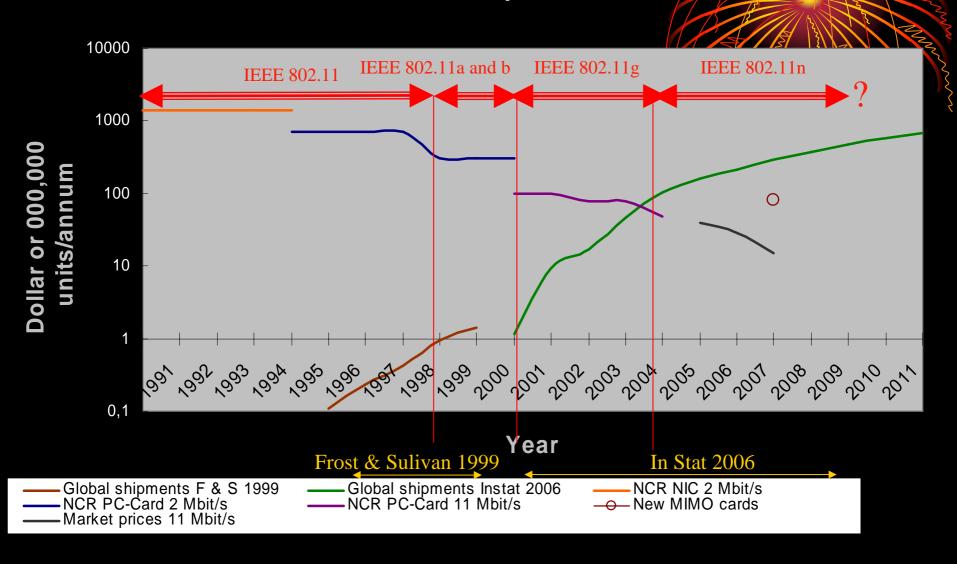

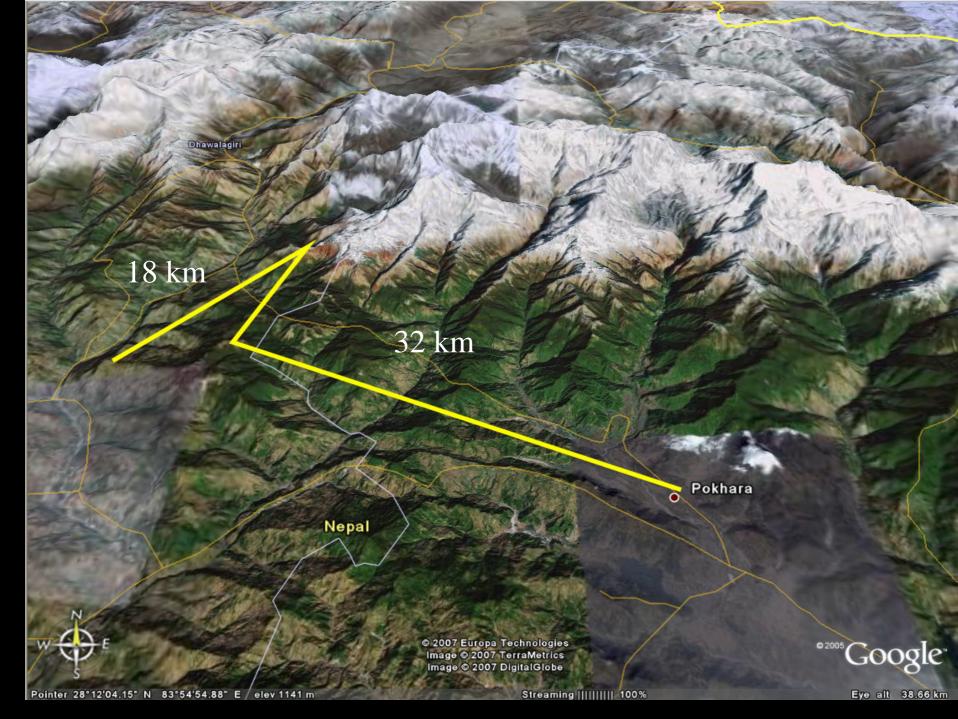




Node of Air-Jaldi network at the foot of the Himalayas, Monkey-proof and solar powered







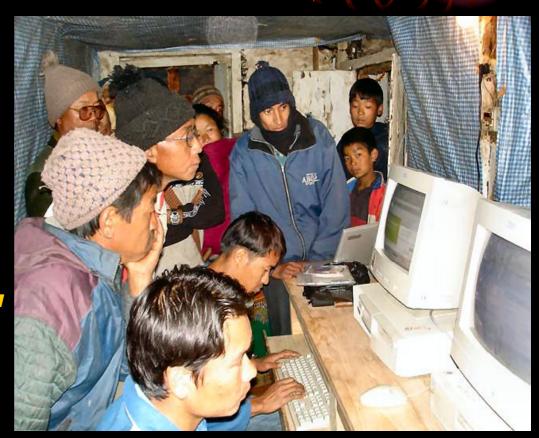

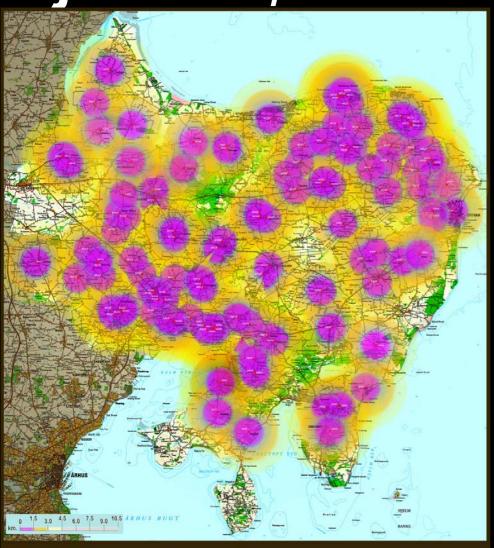

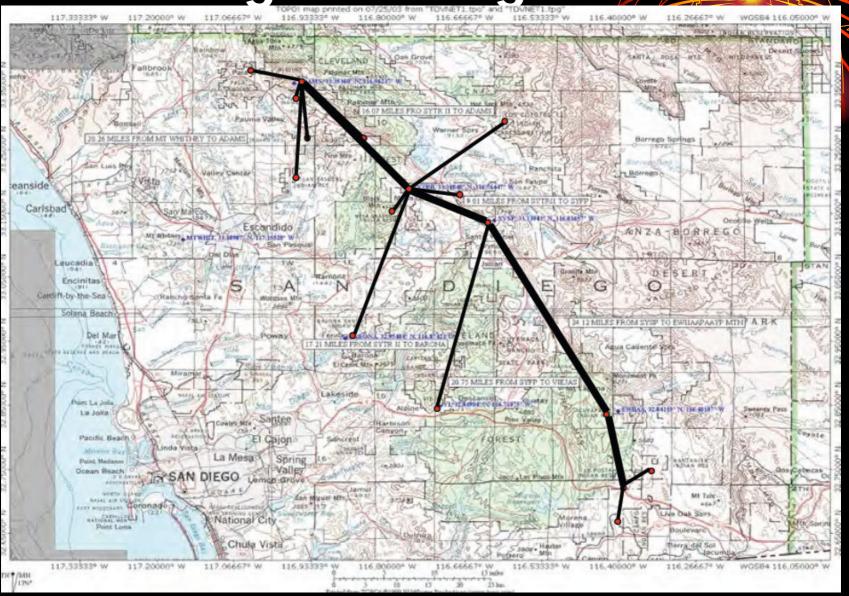


Purple: within 1,5 km from antenna Orange: within 3 km from antenna

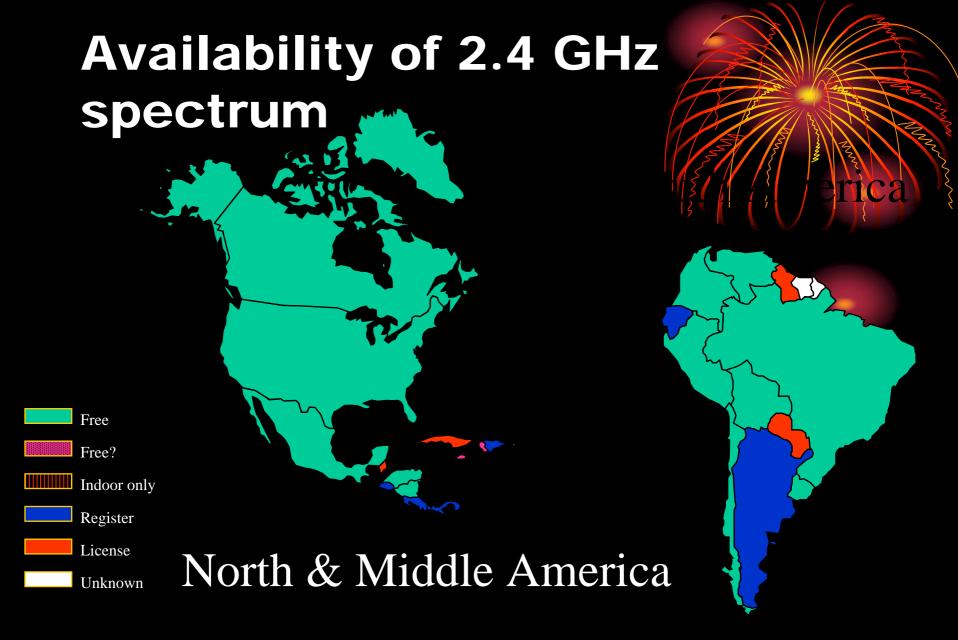
